





How to Register a Finished Cosmetic Product in China?

Background

On January 1, 2021, the Cosmetic Supervision and Administration Regulation (CSAR) came into force as the overarching cosmetic regulation in China. This brought about significant changes in the management of finished cosmetic products in China.

In China, finished cosmetic products are either classified as ordinary or special cosmetic products. This classification determines how the products are managed for compliance on the Chinese market.

Regulation Target:

- > Finished cosmetic product manufacturers, distributors, and traders; and
- > Domestic Responsible Persons in China.


